



Not only will you get to see the Virginia Giant and Raminator monster trucks crush cars, but Diehl Wilson will also share some interesting details about them and introduce you to the drivers during the shows.

Wilson's Virginia Giant has been on the Monster Jam® tour for years, making it to about forty events annually. It has had many paint jobs and is currently sporting a distinctive yellow, blue, and purple scheme on its 2006 Ford body. 
Raminator, a monster truck sponsored by Ram, is the "world's Fastest Monster Truck" according to Guinness World Records® with a record speed of 99.10 mph. Built by Hall Brothers Racing, Raminator stands 10 feet tall and weighs 10,300 lbs. The truck is based on a 2013 Ram 1500/Ram Heavy Duty and boasts 2,000+ horsepower. ■ Non-Judged Showfield

All showfield participants must check in at the showfield counter in the Guest Services building to receive their goody bag. There is no judging on the non-judged showfield.

■ Judged Showfield *Presented by eJudged.com*

All showfield participants must check in at the showfield counter in the Guest Services building to receive their goody bag and

dash card. Judging takes place on Saturday 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. Trucks must be parked in their class and ready to be judged by 10 a.m. Saturday. Judging is conducted by eJudged.com. An explanation of judging standards is on page 11.

■ Club Challenge & Coolest Club

Each year, clubs compete to see which has the most vehicles in attendance, and awards are presented to the top three. There

is also an award presented to the coolest with the coolest hangout. See page 28.

■ Winners' List & Awards

The winners' list is posted at 9 a.m. Sunday in front of the Grandstand and online. After checking the list, go to the Guest Services building to pick up your award and at that time, you may check in for the optional winners' parade. Unclaimed awards will be held for only one year.

Exterior

Body & Paint: 10 POINTS

This category is based on panel alignment & straightness, body kit (fitment, rarity of product), paint/glass condition, shaving, body/lighting conversions, wide body, flares, steps, rails, hitches, winches, light bars and attachments and other custom bodywork.

Suspension: 5 POINTS

Type of suspension (static/air/etc). Also taking into consideration: attention to detail, ride height, undercarriage upgrades, fitment and finish of products, powdercoating/plating, install of air components - as they apply to either lift kits or lowering kits.

Brakes: 5 POINTS

The judges are looking for big brake or custom brake upgrades. Are both the front and rear upgraded? Quality and rarity of product? Also taking into consideration any other braking accessories, brake lines, and custom finishes on the braking system.

Wheels & Tires: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on the uniqueness, rarity, and fitment of the wheels and tires. Also taking into consideration cleanliness and custom finishes.

Overall Quality: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on the overall execution of the vehicle's exterior. Scores will be based on attention to detail, use of color & unique finishes, graphics, quality of finish, accessory lighting, and cleanliness.

Engine Bay

Appearance & Performance: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on engine bolt-ons, custom fabrication, aspiration (turbo/supercharger/etc), motor swap, use of paint and or custom plating/finishing, cleanliness of wiring, and other accessories.

Overall Execution: 10 POINTS

Craftsmanship is key in this category. Judges will evaluate safety upgrades, performance engineering, one-off/custom parts, attention to detail, quality of plating/polishing/finishes, and most importantly level of difficulty (ie motor swap, turbo, shaved bay,

Interior

Passenger Compartment: 10 POINTS

This category focuses on the seating area - taking into consideration the condition and quality of dash, seats, accessories, unique features, roll cage or roll bar(s), use of fabric/materials, and overall upholstery.

Trunk/Bed/Cargo Area - Entertainment vs. Motorsport Theme 10 POINTS

This is a progressive judging category which takes into consideration the theme of the vehicle build. Does the cargo area complement the theme of the vehicles. Are Toneaus, bed covers, liners, cargo equipment and accessories well done, properly installed and fitting theme of the vehicle. Are they clean and prepared for show.

Audio/Show themed vehicles will be scored based on Entertainment, audio install (visual), video sources and tv/monitors, quality/rarity of products, air suspension components installed in bed/cargo area, etc.

Motorsport/Performance themed vehicles will be scored based on fuel cell install, roll cage components in trunk/bed or rear suspension area, suspension components, braces, safety equipment, quality/rarity of products, etc.

Overall Quality: 10 POINTS

Attention to detail, use of color/finishes, materials, fitment, cleanliness, fabrication, level of customization.

Show Quality



The Show Quality portion of the scoresheet is a comprehensive look at the build's overall execution and style. These two categories are judged based on the universal 5-star rating system. Those possible 10 stars count as the final 10 points of your overall score.

Originality/Uniqueness: 5 STARS

Rare vehicles or more common vehicles with unique modifications and rare parts will score higher.

Overall Execution: 5 STARS

Overall quality of build. Fitment throughout all aspects of vehicle. Does the vehicle flow? Is it period or era correct? Is it relevant to current trends? Is the vehicle still functional?

The overall score is based on a possible 100 TOTAL POINTS.
